Walking Together/Synodal Journey during Advent

Pope Francis has invited the entire Catholic Church across the world to take part in a listening journey. As a Church, we are invited to reflect on how we respond to today's problems and needs and how we become a listening Church. Our parish is starting its listening journey in Advent.

In Truro, there will be a Wednesday morning group, following Mass. The first meeting will be on the 1st December at 11am and then on each of the Wednesdays in Advent. Each meeting will last for an hour and a half.

On a Wednesday evening, at 7pm, there will be a parish Zoom meeting and this will also last for an hour and a half. This meeting will also commence on the 1st December. If you are interested in joining the Zoom sessions, please email the parish office: truro@prcdtr.org.uk

The meetings will be led by the Parish Facilitators and will be a time for prayer, reflection, listening to the Word of God, and to each other. Leaflets will be provided for each week, which contain passages of scripture, reflections, and questions to ponder.

It will also be possible for individuals to take part in this listening journey and resources will be made available. Please let the parish office know if you would like copies. Your responses will be included in the feedback the facilitators are asked to make to the Diocesan Synod team.
